

Programme Monitoring and review

Activity on an annual basis - Annual Monitoring

The College monitors courses on an annual basis to ensure that no major difficulties have arisen and that appropriate opportunities for improvement have been identified.

The monitoring carried out in the summer/autumn period. Monitoring includes:

- Handling and considering External Examiners' (Standard's Verifier) reports
- Review of modules

The College is required to reflect on all this information and to produce a written account of the actions which will be taken as a result. The account may encompass a number of related courses which are being monitored together. This written account is retained by the College and forms part of the documentation for College Review.

With the onset of the new annual Monitoring Review by EDEXCEL, then the College will have monitoring reviews every 3rd term.
